Grease – Can It. Cool It. Trash It.

Trash the grease! When cooking anything that leaves grease in the skillet (e.g., bacon), soak up the grease with paper towels or pour it into a container and throw the grease-soaked paper towels or container in the trash. Fats, Oils, and Grease (FOG) can clog sewer lines.

Trash the Wipes!

Do not flush or dump trash or wipes down your toilet. These items clog sewers.



Sewer Easement and Right of Ways

Avoid planting trees, shrubs, or bushes on your property near the sewer lines. Roots from plants and trees can enter, block, and even cause damage to sewers.
